#### GOVERNOR HEALEY ESTABLISHES COMPETITIVENESS COUNCIL TO GROW ECONOMY, STRENGTHEN BUSINESS CLIMATE

One SouthCoast Chamber is honored to be selected as a member of Governor Healey's Competitiveness Council, joining key business and civic leaders from across the Commonwealth. While Massachusetts faces significant challenges in areas like healthcare costs, housing affordability, and energy prices, we're encouraged by the Governor's proactive approach to strengthening our business climate and economic competitiveness. As the voice of the South Coast business community, we look forward to contributing to solutions that will help make our region and state a more affordable and attractive place to live, work, and grow a business.

Press release from The Office of Governor Maura T. Healey:

Governor Maura Healey signed an Executive Order creating the Governor's Advisory Council on Competitiveness to advise her on ways to drive economic growth and strengthen the state's business climate.

Governor Healey appointed Dan Kenary, President & Co-Founder of the Harpoon Brewery, and Mark Nunnelly, Chairman of Toolbox Holdings and Foundation and former Managing Director of Bain Capital, as Chairs of the Competitiveness Council.

They will also offer recommendations on potential actions to strengthen the state's business climate and support growth in existing and emerging industries. They will also assess the impacts of federal policies related to research, education immigration and free trade

"I'm creating this Competitiveness Council to bring everyone to the table – business, labor, state and local leaders – to advise me on action we can take to grow Massachusetts' economic leadership and make us more competitive." "Massachusetts has the talent, research institutions, and entrepreneurial spirit to compete with any region in the world," said Economic Development Secretary Eric Paley. "This council reflects the Governor's commitment to growing our economy by listening to the people who know it best—our business leaders, workers, and innovators—and by bringing together voices from across the Commonwealth to ensure Massachusetts remains the best place to start, scale, and succeed."

"Massachusetts is known as a hub of innovation, talent and entrepreneurship. By working together, we can build on those strengths, grow our economic competitiveness, and make sure our state is a great place to start and grow a business," said Dan Kenary, President & Co-Founder of the Harpoon Brewery. "I'm grateful to Governor Healey for appointing me to this important role, and I look forward to getting to work with the Competitiveness Council."

"At every step, Massachusetts has always been ready to adapt, change and invest in its future. Governor Healey is continuing this tradition in a world that is changing faster than ever," said Mark Nunnelly, Chairman of Toolbox Holdings and Foundation and former Managing Director of Bain Capital. "I'm honored to serve as Co-Chair of her Competitiveness Council, which will bring together a talented group of leaders to make sure we are building that strong future and bolstering our economic competitiveness."

Cape Air has announced new passenger service between New Bedford Regional Airport and Logan International Airport in Boston.



Residents of the Southeastern Massachusetts region will have direct air access to Logan International Airport without having to battle Boston-area road congestion and high parking rates.

In addition, local passengers will be able to pass through TSA security checkpoints in New Bedford, rather than in Boston, making it easy to connect to domestic and international flights departing from Logan.

The 35-minute gate-to-gate flights from New Bedford to Boston are scheduled to depart daily at 8:15 a.m. and 2 p.m., with return flights from Boston scheduled for 1 p.m. and 6:40 p.m. The new flights are scheduled to begin on Sept. 29, 2025, and passengers can purchase tickets starting today on Cape Air's website, www.CapeAir.com.






